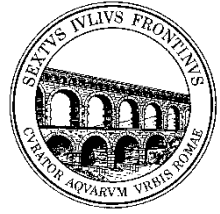

Call for the Frontinus-Award 2027

With members from nearly 20 countries around the world, the Frontinus Society is one of the leading international organizations dedicated to the history of water, energy and pipeline technology. Its scope spans from antiquity to the 19th century. The collaboration between archaeologists and engineers is one of our society's strengths.

The Frontinus Award is presented annually. It recognizes outstanding theses and dissertations at the bachelor's, master's, and doctoral levels dealing with the history of water, energy, and pipeline technology.

The prize amount depends on the type of work:

Bachelor's thesis:	500 €
Master's thesis:	1,000 €
Doctoral dissertation:	2,000 €

These awards include

- the respective prize money,
- a certificate issued by the Frontinus Society,
- mention on the website www.frontinus.de, and
- a three-year membership in the Frontinus Society with no dues.

Acceptance of the Frontinus Award entails an obligation to acknowledge the support provided by the Frontinus Society in lectures and publications.

The following rules must be observed:

1. Only works finished no earlier than 2025 will be accepted.
2. At the time of submission of the prize nomination, the work must be fully completed and assessed.
3. The deadline for submitting the nomination for 2027 is 31 December 2026.
4. The decision on the Frontinus Award will be made by the end of the first quarter of 2027.
